

Anti-Ragging and Mobile Confiscation Committee

The **Anti-Ragging and Mobile Confiscation Committee** is constituted in accordance with the regulations and guidelines issued by the **University Grants Commission (UGC)** and the affiliating Mangalore University. The committee functions with the primary objective of ensuring a safe, disciplined, and student-friendly academic environment within the college campus and hostels.

The committee is committed to maintaining a **ragging-free and harassment-free campus** by promoting a culture of mutual respect, responsibility, and ethical conduct among students. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited and is treated as a serious offense as per the norms prescribed by the UGC and University authorities.

Objectives

- To prevent ragging and related activities within the college campus and hostel premises.
- To maintain discipline and ensure proper student conduct in classrooms and other academic spaces.
- To create awareness among students regarding the legal implications and consequences of ragging.
- To provide a safe and supportive environment for all students, particularly newly admitted students.

Functions and Responsibilities

- The committee members conduct **regular rounds and inspections** in classrooms, corridors, common areas, and hostels to monitor student behavior and ensure adherence to institutional discipline.
- Special attention is given to identifying and preventing any instances of **ragging, harassment, or eve-teasing** within the campus.
- Awareness programmes and guidance are periodically provided to students regarding the **serious legal consequences of ragging** and the importance of maintaining a respectful campus culture.
- The committee promptly investigates any complaints received from students and takes **appropriate disciplinary action** in accordance with institutional rules and statutory regulations.
- Strict and severe punitive action is initiated against students found indulging in ragging or any form of misconduct.

Complaint and Reporting Mechanism

Students who face or witness any form of ragging or harassment may report the matter through the following channels:

- By submitting written complaints in the **suggestion/complaint boxes** placed near the **college office, library, and hostel**.
- By directly approaching the **Coordinator or any member of the Anti-Ragging Committee**.
- By informing the class mentors or faculty members, who will forward the matter to the committee for necessary action.

All complaints are treated with **confidentiality and seriousness**, and appropriate steps are taken to ensure the safety and well-being of the complainant.

Regulation of Mobile Phone Usage

As per the **University regulations**, the use of **mobile phones by students within the college campus** is strictly prohibited during academic hours. The committee monitors compliance with this rule to maintain a focused academic atmosphere.

- If a student is found using or possessing a mobile phone within the campus in violation of the rules, the device will be **confiscated by the committee**.
- The confiscated mobile phones will be **returned to the students at the end of the academic year**, after due verification.

Through these measures, the committee strives to maintain **discipline, academic integrity, and a secure learning environment** for all students.
